- Entry is open to all new and continuing CDU students who are enrolled in at least one unit for Semester 1, 2018, and are residents within Australia.
- Employees of Charles Darwin University and their immediate family can participate but are not eligible to receive prizes.
- Multiple entries not permitted.
- Your contact details will only be used for the purpose of running this competition and for sending you personalised information about mobility programs at CDU.
- Incomplete or incomprehensible entries will be deemed invalid. No responsibility will be taken for lost, late or misdirected entries.
